### Roster Submission/Details

SDYSA will need the following tasks to be completed by **Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup>**. This date will be considered the SDYSA State President's Cup Roster Freeze Date.

- Two Rosters
  - Roster 1: A "Current Certified State Roster" of no more than 22 players. This will be considered your State President's Cup Official Roster. This must be submitted to SDYSA Technical Director, Dale Weiler, via email, [td@southdakotasoccer.com](mailto:td@southdakotasoccer.com)
  - Roster 2: A "Certified State Roster from the first USYS sanctioned competition" the team participated in during the 2018/2019 soccer year must be submitted. \*A minimum of 9 players on the "Current Certified State Roster" must also be on the submitted first USYS sanctioned competition roster.

### Information/Details

- All players on the Certified State Roster must be registered with SDYSA.
- No guest players are eligible to play in President's Cup Competition. Players must be registered to their SDYSA club.
- Game Day Protocol/Check-in Procedure
  - Any teams that have more than eighteen (18) players on their frozen team roster must designate on the roster on game day (which the referees will have at the fields), which players will not be dressing.
  - Players not dressing are allowed to be on the bench but must be wearing street clothes.
  - Player cards must be present at the field.
  - Referees will check the official roster and the player cards prior the start of each match.
  - Players who do not dress in a game (not a part of the 18) are eligible to dress in other President Cup games during the state competition.
  - Each player participating must have a unique player number on their jersey, use of tape or other temporary numbers is not allowed.
  - There is no formal check-in for the event.
  - Bench/coach personnel must be on the official frozen roster and cannot exceed more than four people. Only those bench/coach personnel on the official roster will be allowed to sit on team bench during competition.

### Performance Bond

- The Performance Bond is \$100 per team. This is due from each club on **Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup>** (i.e., # of Teams x \$100). There should be a check made out to South Dakota Youth Soccer Association and mailed to...

### SDYSA Policies and Procedures

#### Article IV – Section E

If notice of a registered team dropping from the NCS State Cup or President's Cup Competitions occurs on or after 14 days prior to either competition, said team will be assessed a fine of \$500 per game

missed in the event. A review of the circumstances behind the team dropping will be reviewed by the Competitive Committee (SDYSA Technical & Executive Director, SDYSA Competitive Director, SDYSA Director of Player Development, East River Representative, West River Representative). If a member of this Committee is a member of the Club being reviewed they would be replaced by another SDYSA Board Member. If necessary, future participation in SDYSA sanctioned events may be impacted. The fined team's association can submit an appeal per the SDYSA Disciplinary Policy, Section 3A of the SDYSA Bylaws

### SDYSA State Event Fees

- All clubs will be billed post event.
  - Half the referee game fees per game played (split between teams)
  - Referee assignor/travel/per diem fees
  - \$50.00 administrative & hosting fee

### Regional Event Fees

- Teams moving on to the Regional President's Cup Competition
  - The Midwest Regional President's Cup Team Fee is TBD
  - Clubs will be invoiced once the state President's Cup concludes.

### Scoring/Bracketing/Scheduling

- **Bracket of Two:** The two clubs drawn as a pair play each other twice, home-and-home. The winner is decided by adding together the **scores** from the two games -- the **aggregate score**. If the **aggregate score** is tied, then the winner is the club that **scored** more goals on its opponent's field (usually referred to as "the away goals rule").
  - **Championship Game 1 will be played on Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup>**
  - **Championship Game 2 will be played on Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup>**
- **Brackets of Three:** Determined in March, 2019. 'Play-in' games will be played on Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup> within the U13B, U13G and U15B division. Winners will face off against the 1 seed on Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup>, in a two-game aggregate scoring competition.
  - **Play In Games will be played Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup>**
  - **Championship Game 1 will be played on Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup>**
  - **Championship Game 2 will be played on Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup>**
- \*For aggregate scoring. Which will occur for the two above scenarios. If the aggregate is tied after game number two on Sunday. Penalty kicks from the mark will determine the champion.
- **Brackets of Four:** Round robin play will determine the Champion.
  - Win = 3 points. Tie = 1 point. Loss = 0 points.
  - If at the conclusion of bracket play, two or more teams have the same point total, champions will be determined by using the following tiebreakers in the order listed until a team is eliminated. Once a team is eliminated with this set of tiebreakers, advancement among the remaining teams shall again be determined by the tiebreakers in the order listed starting with number one (1), head to head competition.
    - Winner of Head to Head
    - Winner of most games.
    - Goal differential (goals scored minus goals against) with a maximum of four (4) per game.
    - Fewest goals allowed.

- Kicks from the penalty mark.
- Coin toss if kicks from the penalty mark cannot be scheduled.
- **Round Robin Play begins Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup> (Each team will play 2 games)**
- **Round Robin Play will conclude Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup> (Each will play 1 game)**
