Phase 3 protocols will primarily consist of general guidelines set forth by the CDC, US Soccer, and local Government entities. You will see that majority of the past guidelines regarding distancing and suspending play have been lifted as SDYSA is taking into account the varying nature of the pandemic throughout the state, and how each community is affected differently. SDYSA strongly encourages each club to follow ALL guidelines set by their local governing bodies and keep player's health and safety first and foremost.

DISTANCING



Clubs may move to full team training and begin to take part in games within their own club or against other clubs. Please encourage members to follow all hygiene practices and safety protocols listed below. *Reminder to all members that this situation is fluid and things could change quickly should there be a change in Covid developments.*

HYGIENE PRACTICES



DO NOT attend any events if you feeling sick or have a temperature.



Continue to practice proper hand washing and sanitizer use when necessary.



Encourage players and members to sanitize and clean equipment.

SAFETY PROTOCOLS



Clubs need to ensure all their staff, coaches, members, and players are following all guidelines set by local governments.



Clubs should develop a plan for a potential exposure or positive case of Covid-19 among their membership.



Parents/Guardians are encouraged to follow the guidance from their clubs regarding getting out of their cars, carpooling, etc.

FLEXIBILITY



In Phase 3 SDYSA has lifted travel, competition, and sanctioning restrictions. Please continue to make your member's and player's health a top priority as you plan your team activities.
